The maximum length of the manuscript is six pages, DIN A4, including figures and tables, page margins top 3 cm, left, right, and bottom 2.5 cm. Use font Times New Roman 12 pt, also for the title, author names, and affiliations.

Deadline: Your manuscript must be submitted not later than February 28, 2010, to me at franco@feq.unicamp.br, with copy to Martin.Peter@uni-potsdam.de.
